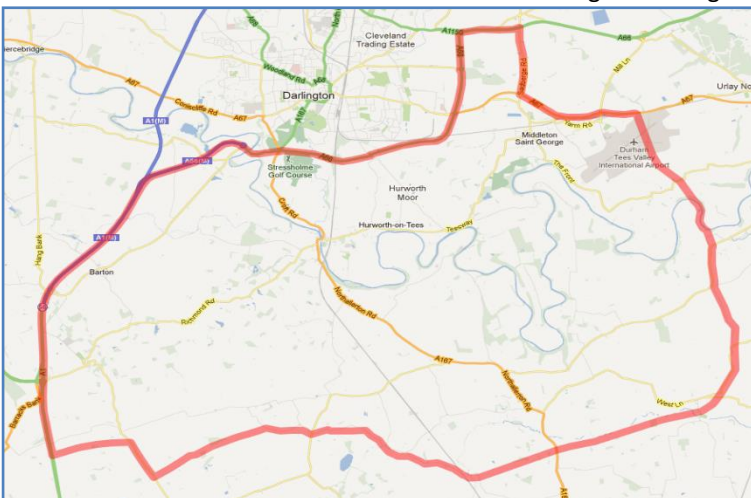

## Our Appointment System

The simplest way to access medial care is to use eConsult, which is accessed via a link on the front page of the website. eConsult does not require a login. If you are unable to do this please telephone the surgery but understand that lines may be busy. All appointment requests will be triaged and allocated to a call back from the most appropriate person. If you cannot keep an appointment, please inform us as soon as possible.

## Opening Times

Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm. Door opens at 8.30am. The surgery offers pre-booked extended hours on a Tuesday and Thursday from 7.30am.

## Disabled Access

All our clinical services are provided from the ground floor and there are automatic entrance doors.

## Out of Hours Arrangements

Out of hours services are provided during the following periods:

Monday to Friday 6pm to 8am

Weekends Friday 6pm to Monday 8am

Bank Holidays from 6pm the night before until 8am the morning after.

## Walk-in Centre

This is located at Darlington Memorial Hospital where it is open 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

## Repeat Prescriptions

These may be requested using the postbox outside the surgery, e-mail to [rockliffe.prescriptions@nhs.net](mailto:rockliffe.prescriptions@nhs.net), or online. You need to have been given login details by reception. You may then visit the SystmOnline website at <https://systmonline.tpp-uk.com>. Please remember to allow 2 full working days for processing.

## Dispensing

Patients who live further away from our surgery are dispensed their medication from our in-house dispensary. This dispensary operates during normal surgery hours.

## Laboratory results

Depending on the test undertaken, these can take up to 2 weeks to be ready. Please ring for your results in the afternoon.

## Patient Rights & Responsibilities

This practice will not tolerate aggressive or abusive behaviour from patients. Such patients will be removed from the list and the police may be notified.

We are not a training practice but occasionally have students in the surgery. You will always be asked if they can be present during your consultation and have the right to refuse.
